Appellation MERCUREY 1er CRU CLOS L'EVEQUE (Red)

Size:

4,40 ac / 2 ha

Grapes:

100 % Pinot noir

Position:

Facing East on chalky-clay soil

Drinking:

Le Clos l'Evêque is the most well-known 1er Cru of Mercurey by its surface (21ha), but also by the regularity of its quality. It is the most "Côte de Beaune" of the Mercurey with raspberry notes and quite pronounced floral aromas (violet).

Serving suggestions:

Balanced, our Clos l'Evêque accompanies an entire meal; you will have the most beautiful harmony of Pinot Noir in Burgundy.

Keeping time:

Three to seven years.
